Live farm animal sale or trade at FG Farmers Market Wednesday

May 17, 2016

This week there will be a live animal sale at the Fair Grove Farmers Market beginning at 3:30 p.m. Wednesday, May 18, for anyone wanting to buy, sell or trade. The Paddy Wagon Grill will be on site, providing a full menu to market-goers. Payment for items can be made in cash, debit or credit cards.

Preregistration for the live animal sale is \$5, or \$10 the day of the sale. It will take place on the Wommack Mill grounds and is restricted to farm animals only, no pets. Future dates for the live animal sale are June 15 and July 20.

Along with the live animal sale, the grower-producer-crafter-only market will have the usual in-season vegetables, as well as fruits, local honey, jellies and jams, meats from grain-fed livestock, raw milk, eggs and baked goods, all produced or grown by vendors from Fair Grove and the surrounding area.

The Paddy Wagon Grill will provide vending for the market this week and will feature a full menu. The owner, Mark Yount, is a Le Cordon Bleu chef with more than 40 years of experience and has a background in fine-dining restaurants. He opened the Paddy Wagon Grill for

business in August 2015.

The Fair Grove Farmers Market has operated since 2000 and has won Farmers Market of the Year awards for 2010 and 2012 and received a USDA grant in 2015. The market is open from 3:30 to 6:30 p.m. every Wednesday from late April to September and is on the Historical Wommack Mill property, Mo. 125 and Main Street in Fair Grove.
