The Greater Springfield Farmers Market kicks off at 8:30 a.m. April 9 on the northwest corner of the Battlefield Mall parking lot at the corner of Glenstone and Battlefield. In 32 years, it has grown to more than 100 vendors and become a very visible part of the local food scene.

The Nixa Area Farmers' Market also starts in April, though no word yet on exactly when. The market
